## Gomer School Historical Association Box Lunch Picnic/Open House

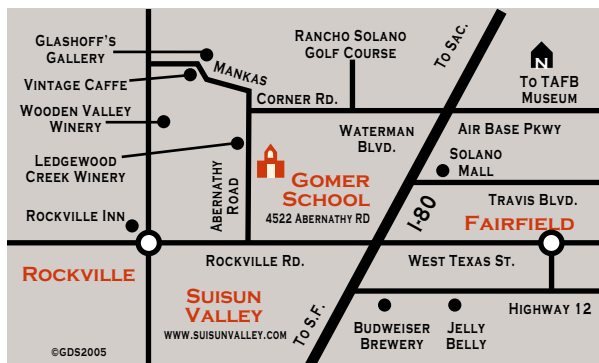
On Saturday, May 14, 2005, 12 noon - 2pm

Gomer School is a rare, classic 1-room red school house amongst the farmlands and vineyards of beautiful Suisun Valley. Named after William and Jane Gomer who donated the land, the original structure was built in 1857, burned down in 1900, and the present building was rebuilt the same year. It has been carefully preserved from generous supporters and Gomer School Historical Association. Formed in 1988, GSHA's mission is to preserve and collect pre-1930 antiques to create a mini-museum.
